MATHIAS AND LENNON – A MODEL FOR CORRUPT, CORPORATE BEHAVIOR IN THE UNITED STATES

The owners of General Die Casters, Inc., Mathias and Lennon, are the worst type of employers in the United States. Their greedy, childish behavior toward their own workforce has prevented you from securing the contract that you are entitled to under law. That law says that after you win your election, the employer 'must bargain in good faith.' There has been no "good faith bargaining" for the past year. The violations that have been filed by the Union and upheld by the National Labor Relations Board have proven that there has been no good faith bargaining by Mathias and Lennon.

Mathias, Lennon, and their hired union-buster continue to violate Federal Labor laws. It is impossible to get a fair contract when an employer continues to violate Federal Labor laws and the rights of the workers, who legally voted for Union representation. As a result of their illegal, corrupt, immoral corporate behavior, at the shop and at negotiations the Teamsters are:

TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING NEGOTIATIONS.

WHAT THIS MEANS

1. We will not continue to negotiate with the employer until the Labor Board reaches a settlement on all the charges that have been, and will be filed and upheld by the National Labor Relations Board in Cleveland.
2. We will have our meeting on Sunday, August 23rd at 11:00 a.m. at Teamsters Local 24.
3. We will need you to continue to support and defend the Union that you have voted on and the Union that you continue to build at General Die Casters.

This action was found necessary by your elected negotiating committee and voted on by them. Once the Labor Board reaches settlement, through agreement or through a Board order, we will then return to the bargaining table.
